





# Train performance at Cleethorpes railway station

How reliable were train services at Cleethorpes station recently?

## What are we doing to improve?

- Next three months:**  
We’re working with Network Rail to look at reducing speed restrictions on the line between Doncaster and Cleethorpes, so your journeys can be faster and more reliable
- Next year:**  
Supporting Network Rail with making technical improvements to the canal bridge at Keadby to improve its reliability, especially in hot weather
- Longer-term:**  
We’re working closely with Network Rail on ways of improving the line to make services faster, including reducing the number of foot crossings, which can slow trains down

Punctuality is the percentage of trains that arrived within three minutes of the scheduled time.  
Cancelled means the percentage of trains that were scheduled to, but didn’t, stop at this station. This does not include trains which didn’t stop at this station if the decision was made before 22:00 the previous day.
